Get ready for Fall “Ministry Sunday”:

It is our responsibility as volunteers who help the elderly or the youth in any way need to have a Police Information Check.

Our Vulnerable People must be protected as you would wish your family members to be protected.

Volunteers come to our Police Information Check Blitz

- **Wednesday June 29th, 6 pm to 8 pm**
- **St. Luke’s Church on Northmount Drive near the Northland Mall.**
- **Two forms of ID needed:**
 - **Bring Original Driver’s Licence (or other official photo id)**
 - **and Alberta Health Care Card**
 - **They will photocopy –**
(note: photocopies will not be accepted – they must see the original).
- **These forms cannot be filled out ahead of time. They must be filled out in front of the signer.**
- **Blue ink must be used so there is no confusion as to the original.**

Who are the signers?:

Staff from St. Luke’s: Barbara Banham, Father David Meadows and Margaret DeWald

If under 18, parents must give permission to do the Police Information Check so they must be present with the child.

How it works:

- **Signer sends forms to the Police Service.**
- **Confidential information does not get released to us.**
- **Your Police Information Check: Either comes back from the police service with the full clearance box checked or the other box will be checked and say further information required.**
- **You will be let know right away to respond in 30 days at the police station with when and where to go.**
- **The original documents are to be kept in the originating parish.**

Note:

Duplicate birthdays from anyone else in the world who has been a “bad boy/girl” could cause you to need to provide further information, simply based on your date of birth.

We never find out what is the problem, that is confidential between you and the police.

Police Check takes 4-6 weeks so please....
