Strengthening our Parish Communities

The primary concern on behalf of the Church and the Diocese is the well-being of all persons involved, particularly the health and well-being of children, adolescents and vulnerable adults who could be victims of misconduct.

For those parishioners in ministries deemed 'high risk' in 2011

- The Police Information Check (PIC) you went through will expire this year.
- In order to continue the very important work you offer in your ministry, we ask that you come to us and renew your PIC.

ADDED to the 'high risk' list are all key holders!

- Parishioners who like to hold parish keys (Church and Hall) for your ministry, you are to surrender keys.
- Apply for a PIC and attend the Model Code of Conduct workshop.
- For both, renewals from 2011 and for our key holders, please contact the parish office for a PIC appointment (403.274.4349).
Please bring 2 pieces of ID.

REGISTRATION:

Sacraments and Sunday Children's Programs

- Mark your calendar for **October 4 and 5th**.
After all Masses - to register your child to receive the sacraments OR attend our Sunday Programs.
- To volunteer as a catechist for sacraments or Sunday children's programs. Catechists needed for all sacraments & Sunday Programs.

Registration Fees
 - for First Holy Eucharist (Gr. 2 & up) \$20
 - for First Reconciliation (Gr. 4 & up) \$20
 - for Confirmation (Gr. 6 & up) \$30
(max. \$50 per family)
- (photocopy of baptism certificates and parish registration required)
- **Note: fees can be paid a few weeks later.**

Sunday 11 am Mass Children's Programs

- **No fee – a parent must volunteer at least twice a requirement.** There must be at least 2 volunteers for every 15 children or the class cannot meet.
- **Sunday with Jesus – 4 and 5 year olds**
- **Children's Liturgy Gr. 1-3 Registration**
- These are not drop-in programs!
- Please do not send your little ones to Children's Liturgy if they do not fit the age parameter.
