November is the month of deceased ... not just for those who have died in wars (Remembrance Day).

In our parish, we offer all Masses in November for those who have died in the parish this past year.

**Instead of individual Mass Intentions, we ask parishioners to print all the names of those whom they wish to remember.**

**(All Souls Envelopes and pages are available in the entrance.)**

WE put these names in a “Book of Remembrance” and mention names during all Masses offered in November. Although we may not be able to mention each and every name, our “Intentions” are for all of them.

Also, we remember those who received burials from our Parish this past year. A special display has been created to enhance our prayers for those who have died in the past year and for the month of December last year.

Offerings for these Masses are voluntary, but I encourage you to be generous. Whatever offering you give in excess of the regular offering (for which there is no limit on the number of names or even, pages of names), is sent to priests who need Mass Intentions.

There are many retired priests who need Mass Intentions to offer at their Masses. Our Diocese has appealed to our parishes to send them excess Mass Intentions. Please help them...
