"The Annulment Process is a part of the Church's healing ministry." Pope Francis has significantly altered the process with two formal documents. He is not promoting the nullity of marriages, but the quickness of the process, as well as a correct simplicity.

During the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy (Dec. 8 2015 to Nov. 20, 2016), fees normally requested with applications and declarations will be

waived. (Of course, fixed costs remain as a part of the process; therefore donations are received with gratitude.)
