

Fortunately used textiles do have utility and value, and this creates opportunity to divert textiles out of the waste stream, revive the product's life, or reincarnate the raw materials.

TCTR is a 100% Canadian business, diverting over 15 million lbs of textiles a year through reuse, re-purpose or recycling. 99% of textiles are diverted due to their collection-to-use business model. TCTR has been successfully operating in Western Canada for 3 decades, including a locally-based partnership recycling program that enables the public to recycle their unwanted clothing. This recycling program generates hundreds of thousands of dollars annually for local charities, schools, and non-profit organizations. Collected textiles, ranging from usable clothing to industrial wiping rags and textile waste, are all processed in Canada.

Useable clothing is shipped to developing countries, mostly in Africa. Because of the efficient processing system we have at TCTR, we are able to deliver clothing to those who need it, at a price they can afford.
